From the start at the Church of our Lady the way to the winepress leads parallel to the rock path through the wonderful historic terraced vineyards. Beginning with place of interest (8) you will stay on the convenient way and get to the Staffelsteigerplätzle, where you will see the modern part of the vineyards of Esslingen. Soon you will reach the winepress in Mettingen. The urban railway (S-Bahn) or the bus take you back to Esslingen.
